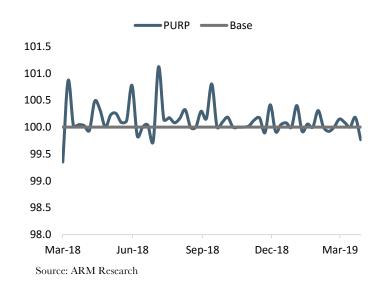

## The PENTAD - Urban Retail Price Tracker

### Price pressures on a hushed note

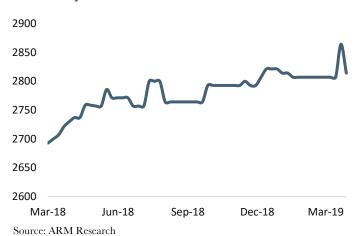
To determine how retail prices have moved on average, we fashioned out a Pentad Urban Retail Price Index (PURP) which adopts April 1st to April 8th as a base period. The PURP index accords 30% weightings apiece to consumer and commodities prices, 20% weighting to the brewery basket with a further 20% distributed evenly between cement and cooking gas prices.

Across the sectors, price evolution is monitored on a weekly basis while we adopt 0.6%, 0.0%, and -0.6% as indicators for volume expansion from prior week, no change in volumes, and week on week output contraction (respectively) in a manner slightly akin to CBN's PMI methodology.

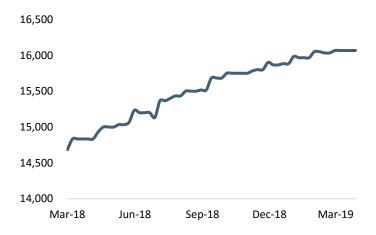
- Our Urban Retail Price Tracker the PURP index recorded a modest increase of 0.20% MoM to 111.8 pts in March (vs 0.28% MoM in February). Prices were relatively muted across board, with just slight increases in the brewery and commodities basket.
- In the consumer basket, average prices moderated 0.09% MoM, driven by a moderation in the price of *Knorr* − down by 0.8% MoM to №677. On the flipside, prices for other products in this basket remained flat in the month.
- Prices in the brewery basket inched slightly higher by 0.46%
   MoM following increases in price of Star (+0.77% MoM),
   Satzenbrau (+0.43% MoM) and Guinness (+0.43% MoM).
- Average price in the **commodities basket** recorded a slower pace of increase over March with prices rising by **0.16% MoM** (**February: +0.44% MoM**). Prices of *vegetable oil* and *rice* were higher by 0.96% MoM and 0.54% MoM respectively. Elsewhere, *Palm Oil* prices continued to decline over the month (-1.74% MoM) following improved harvest and supply to the market. It is worthy to note that palm oil prices are usually at the lowest point in the year during the months of March and April due to harvest season. However, palm oil prices were 2.8% higher YoY in March.
- Prices in the oil & gas sector witnessed an uptick of 0.47%
   MoM over March largely on the back of higher lubricants
   price.
- Prices in the **cement sector** stayed flat over the month, printing at a retail price of \(\frac{\mathbf{N}}{2}600\)/ bag while wholesale price averaged \(\frac{\mathbf{N}}{2}400\)/bag putting at a 8% premium to retail prices.

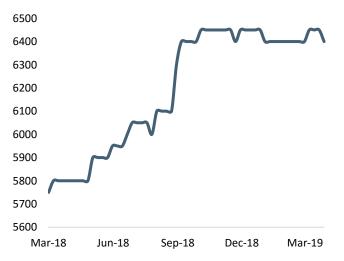

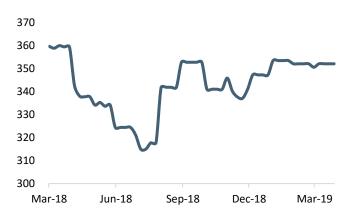

#### Oil & Gas Sector



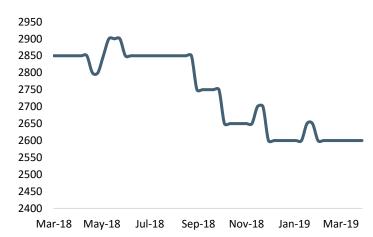
