- GTCO BUY (FVE: \\$33.22): The recently released Q122 results shows a recovery in interest income driving by loan growth and suspected repricing of loans. Non-interest Income also saw a 7% growth despite a decline in foreign exchange trading income. We expect the addition of the non-bank subsidiaries to increase shareholders' value by leveraging cross-selling opportunities in its banking business as we expect half-year performance to reflect this. Hence, we maintain a STRONG BUY rating on GTCO with a Target Price of \\$33.22, representing a potential upside of 42.0%.
- **UBA- BUY (FVE: ₩10.80):** The lender is on course to hit our estimates for the year based on its first quarter performance. Both interest and non-interest income reported double-digit increases, and this reflected in bottom-line growth. We expect this performance to be sustained upon higher loan growth relative to 2021 and increased digital banking drive. Hence, we rate UBA a **BUY** with a Target Price of **★**10.80, representing a potential upside of 34.1%.
